**Declaration Of Intent To Enter Into Marriage  
at The Church Of St. James The Apostle (Guelph)  
Diocese Of Niagara \* Anglican Church Of Canada**

We declare that we intend to enter into marriage which we acknowledge to be a union in faithful love, to the exclusion of all others on either side, for better or for worse, until we are separated by death. We undertake to prepare ourselves for the exchange of vows at our wedding, recognizing that by this mutual exchange of vows our marriage will be established. We intend thereafter to fulfill the purposes of marriage: mutual friendship, support, and comfort of one another; the procreation of children (if it may be); and the creation of a relationship in which sexuality may serve personal fulfillment in a community of faithful love.

Anglican Church of Canada*

Wedding fees for a full ceremony including stole fees, flowers, music, and bulletin for supporting members of the parish and their immediate children are \$600.00. This fee must be paid in cash not less than one week before the wedding. Non members are asked to consider making an additional donation of between \$150 and \$250.00 to support the ongoing ministry of this parish. A tax receipt will be issued for this donation in January every year. A \$100 dollar non refundable deposit must accompany this application in order to hold the date.

There will normally be two or three meetings at which the couple will discuss aspects of Christian marriage, the marriage service, what the promises mean etc. with the Rector or other appointed cleric. These meetings are mandatory. A marriage preparation class is also required the details of which will be discussed with the Rector.

All aspects of the liturgy fall under the direction of the Rector and the final decision on any additions or changes to the service as outlined in the Book of Alternative Services rests with him/her alone. Anglican clergy from outside the parish may only officiate with the permission of the Rector. Anglican clergy from outside the Diocese and clergy from other denominations may only participate with the permission of both the Rector and the Bishop of Niagara.
